Set up methods like fingerprint or facial recognition for account login and/or payments where you can.



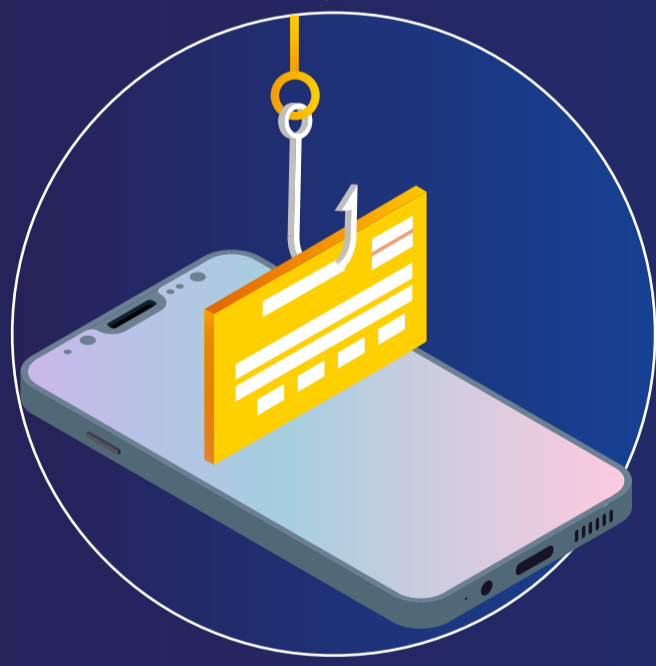
Find the right website

Look for the padlock icon when browsing. The web address should begin with https instead of http – 's' indicates secure.



Pay it safe

Check your statements regularly for any unusual or suspicious transactions. Be mindful about publicly sharing information that identifies you, like your address, and never share your PINs or passwords with anyone.



Beware of phishing scams

Be careful of unsolicited and suspicious emails or phone calls as most financial institutions or government agencies wouldn't call or email to request financial information out of the blue. If in doubt, don't click on any links or download files.



Complete your purchase at checkout with ease

Look for one-click options at checkout, to shop online easily without the need to insert your card details every time.

Install the latest software on your computer, tablet or phone.
